Initiatives for Manufacturer Break-out Sessions:

- 1) Best procedures for installation of insulation
 - a. TIAA members have historically referenced CINI and MICA guidelines
 - b. TIAA will adopt procedures being worked on by TIAC to avoid conflicts
 - c. TIAA will reference and provide links to TIAC procedures
- 2) Creating awareness of relevant technical standards
 - a. TIAA will list relevant standards with links on the website
 - b. TIAA will host presentations on standards at TIAA meetings for attendees. Presentations may be recorded for later viewing
 - c. TIAA members will request spots at TIAA meetings to present on a standard
 - d. Next meeting in Feb 2019, currently has a spot for Chris from Reflex Manufacturing to present on ASTM C16-95
- 3) Corrosion Under Insulation (CUI)
 - a. Industry has not determined the absolute best way to mitigate CUI, therefore if TIAA publishes recommendations it may be held accountable if they do not work as expected. Therefore, TIAA will focus on promoting education regarding CUI
 - b. Members of TIAA to send suggestions for educational courses (such as a week-long course at SAIT) and documents (such as relevant NACE documents, white papers presented at Trade Shows) on CUI, TIAA will list these courses and documents on the website
 - c. TIAA will work to provide discounts/subsidies on these courses for TIAA members
 - d. TIAA website will list members who have completed courses, and which courses they have completed, as well as their credentials, so as to inform the industry of whom they can reach out to for consultation or assistance
